

Woods I (1 Semester)

This course will be geared towards learning the safe and efficient use of tools and equipment along with basic maintenance, and the types of materials and processes used in woodworking. A lot of time will be spent on reading rulers and tape measures. When it comes to building any project, proper planning and design is critical so we will spend a fair amount of time in this area. The students will gain an understanding and experience in proper sawing, proper nailing, proper drilling, proper planning, proper chiseling, proper sanding, proper staining, finishing, and painting. The students will also learn the different fasteners along with proper gluing and clamping techniques. A project or projects will be constructed utilizing the concepts learned during this class.

This class will benefit any student as the processes used will benefit them in everyday life as there is always something around the house that needs a process learned in this class.

There will be a shop fee of \$10.00 to cover the cost of wood used for practicing the techniques used in woodworking. The student will be responsible for paying for projects they construct for themselves.
