

WOODS II Grading Information

This class is designed for advanced techniques in woodworking. While it is mostly a hands-on class with little classroom work, there will be a weekly grade given for character (worth 30 points per week) and it will be based upon the expectations I have set for students in my class. You can see these expectations on the Woods II Main Page.

I will have occasional quizzes and the students will be graded on their ability to complete work details as assigned to them. Quality work will be expected and you will be graded accordingly.

I grade on a total points system so all you have to do is take the total points you have earned and divide that number by the total points possible, and you will come up with your percentage.

Example:

Let's say at midterm (4 weeks period) you have 100 character points out of 120 possible. Let's say you have 60 out of 80 points on a couple of quizzes. Then let's add in 35 out of 40 points on assigned building.

All together you have earned 195 points out of a possible 240 points.
 $195 \text{ divided by } 240 = 81\%$

So your mid term grade would be a B-.

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO KEEP UP ON YOUR GRADE AND TO MAKE SURE YOU HAVE TAKEN ALL QUIZZES AND HAVE EVERYTHING TURNED IN THAT REQUIRES GRADING.
